The police department, with over 700 police officers is the largest department in the City of Orlando. Citizens often ask how they can get more information about public safety and crime. The Orlando Police Department is joining several other law enforcement agencies across the nation to publish crime data on the National Crime Map at [Crime Reports.com](#). Crime Reports is the largest and most accurate online resource for up-to-date crime and sex offender information. Citizens can access the integrated crime map and receive email crime alerts for free at [www.CrimeReports.com](#). By providing this information to our citizens and visitors, the Orlando Police Department is working to enhance its crime prevention and crime reduction efforts.

You can receive crime alerts by email based on location and crime type. You can receive these updates daily, weekly or monthly. Sign up at [crimereports.com](#).

You can also get up to the minute (within ten minutes) 'real time' crime information at [cityoforlando.net/police](#). The police department lists the active calls being handled by its police officers on the website
