Peanut oil

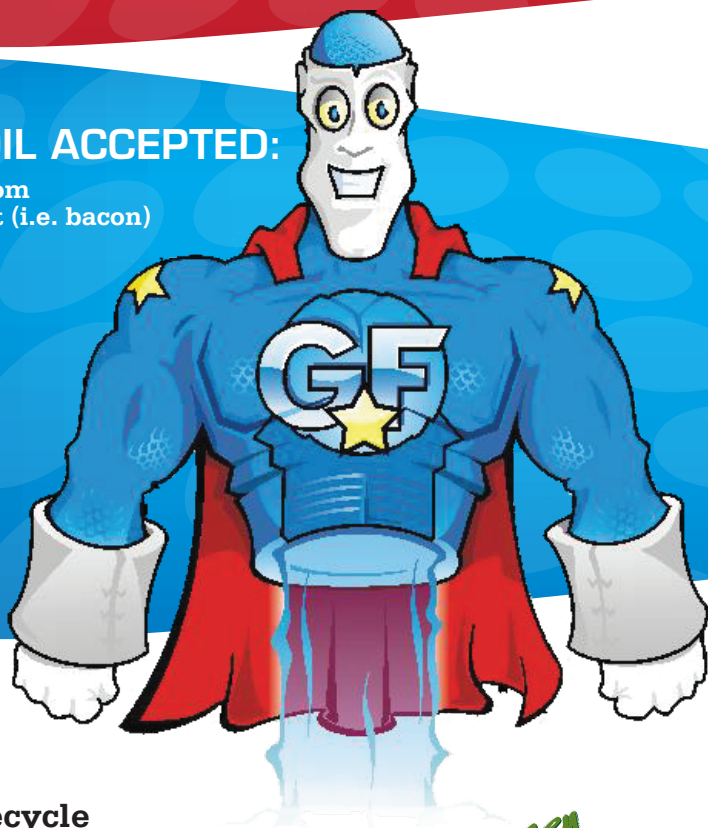
Sesame oil
