Chairman Ed Carson began the meeting with welcome, opening remarks and introductions.

He proceeded to provide a brief summary of the previous two Subcommittee meetings.

The group entered into a discussion about Chapter Eight of the Downtown Outlook Plan. Everyone agreed that this document would be instrumental in providing guidance about the neighborhood. The Committee agreed that the City's Displacement and Relocation Policy should be reviewed and that the City should enforce the code enforcement laws uniformly throughout the neighborhood.

Mr. Carson suggested that the Subcommittee provide recommendations and then subsequently prioritize (i.e. short term vs. long term).

The Subcommittee requested a list of incentives from staff that are available to promote affordable housing in the Parramore neighborhood. Staff will provide this information at the next meeting.

Mr. Carson reviewed the timeline to complete recommendations for submission to the Executive Committee.

The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, January 20, 2004 in the evening. Chairman Carson will contact members with the time and location at a later time.

There being no further discussion, Chairman Carson concluded the meeting at 5:30 p.m.
