Chairman Greg Clendenin began the meeting at 10:40 a.m., with welcome, opening remarks and introductions. His jurisdiction includes Osceola County and Orange County. Judge Lawson proceeded to share an overview of the criminal justice process. A Criminal Punishment Code Score Sheet was passed out for Subcommittee members to review.

Judge Lawson opened the floor for questions from the Subcommittee members. Discussion ensued.
