Chairman Brian Butler began the meeting with welcome and remarks in regards to the meeting logistical adjustment. Since the 8:30 a.m. Mayor's Parramore Task Force meeting was posted on the city's web site and not with the City Clerk's Office, the Executive Committee met to go over the preliminary recommendations, which consist of goals, basic steps, implementers and timeline that expanded from the previous draft goals submitted. The Subcommittee Chairs and Vice Chairs presented preliminary recommendations:

Greg Clendenin, Chair, Public Safety/Public Works, John Ehrig, Vice Chair, Master Planning/Zoning, Veronica Anderson, Chair, Social Services/Education and Lonnie Thompson, Vice Chair, Housing.

Discussions ensued. Chairman Butler thanked Subcommittee Chairs and Vice Chairs.

Subsequently, the Mayor's Parramore Task Force Executive Committee members reviewed and accepted the Wednesday, March 3, 2004, Executive Committee meeting minutes.

*Other Business*

Chairman Butler commented on the schedule of the next Mayor's Parramore Task Force meeting that will be scheduled on Wednesday, March 24, or Thursday, March 25, 8:30 a.m. at Orlando City Hall and location is to be determined based upon availability. Chairman Butler commented that several Subcommittees share similar recommendations and this should be outlined. Mr. Clendenin had concerns regards to modifying the text without losing the meaning of the preliminary recommendations. Mr. Hawkins clarified that staff will take the preliminary recommendations and create a format that everyone can use to input their data without changing the meaning.

Mr. Thompson commented regards to the Subcommittees' commonality between education, code enforcement and crime concerns. Discussions ensued regards to the creating of the document and final input prior to printing for dissemination.

Ms. Anderson stated concerns with the Social Services/Education third goal that need to be collapsed to include goals one and three. Ms. Anderson additionally mentioned by merging the language, that particular goal touches the heart of man with the assistance of the churches, businesses and training programs.

Chairman Butler thanked Executive Committee members for their input. Chairman Butler commented on the oversight for implementation and the process to be discussed at the next meeting.

There being no further discussion, Chairman Butler concluded the meeting at 10:50 a.m.
