Discussion ensued. Chairman Smith advised to cancel all IME appointments until we receive a job description. Chairman Smith asked the Board attorney for a legal opinion for applicants who have applied for a disability pension but have resigned voluntarily. S. Kaufman advised that if they resign prior to finding out if there would be a light duty position available, the Board would advise them at their disability pension hearing if the Chief would offer them a light duty position and if they can be recalled.
