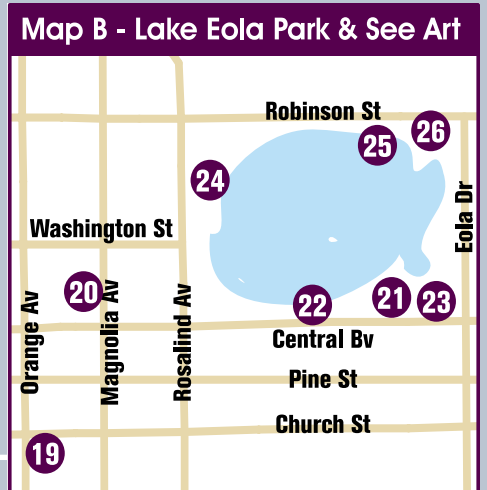


In addition to the galleries at City Hall and Harry P. Leu Gardens the City of Orlando's Public Art Program oversees twenty-six major works of art located throughout the city.

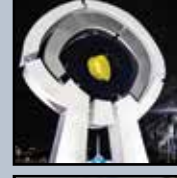

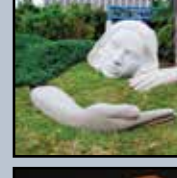
