## 100-102 W. Church Street



Joseph Bumby, Sr. came from England in 1873. He started selling hay, grain, and fertilizer from a warehouse on Church Street. When the railroad came in 1880, his warehouse was used as the depot and he was the ticket agent. In 1886, Bumby built this structure and started a successful hardware business. Bumby Hardware remained a family business until it closed in 1966.
