Note 1: "Deviation" is a percentage measure of the numerical separation between the total population of a proposed district and the ideal district population of 39,819. To protect equal voting rights, the goal is to get as close as practicable to 0%, representing zero deviation from the ideal district population.

Note 2: Split Block population is the result of roof top count of a "Census Block" that is "Split" by a District; Demographic data reflects "Whole Census Blocks Total Population"
