I. CALL TO ORDER

City Clerk Denise Aldridge called the meeting to order at 4:04p.m.

II. PUBLIC COMMENT

City Clerk Denise Aldridge asked if there was any public comment, and David Rucker indicated he had wanted a count of the number of ballots that were challenged and that he had been given that number by the Supervisor of Elections staff. He had no further comment.

Lawanna Gelzer spoke on behalf of Betty Gelzer and Cynthia Harris, out of concern for the harvesting of absentee ballots. Ms. Gelzer also expressed her wish that the City's Canvassing Board be made up of others besides City officials, and that this and future Canvassing Board meetings be recorded and made available for public record for transparency purposes. Ms. Gelzer indicated she would be recording this Canvassing Board meeting.

**III. MINUTES OF CANVASSING BOARD ORGANIZATION MEETING ON
TUESDAY, AUGUST 8, 2017**

It was moved by Commissioner Patty Sheehan, seconded by City Clerk Denise Aldridge, and vote was unanimous to accept the Minutes of the Canvassing Board Organizational Meeting on Tuesday, August 8, 2017.

MINUTES OF PUBLIC TEST OF VOTING EQUIPMENT ON THURSDAY, OCTOBER 26, 2017

It was moved by Commissioner Tony Ortiz, seconded by Commissioner Patty Sheehan, and vote was unanimous to accept the Minutes of the Public Test of Voter Tabulation Equipment on Thursday, October 26, 2017.

IV. RANDOM SELECTION OF RACE FOR REQUIRED AUDIT

According to FS 101.591, immediately following the certification of each election, the canvassing board responsible for certifying the election shall conduct a manual audit of the voting systems used in selected precincts. It was determined that the precincts chosen for the audit would be randomly selected by placing a single sheet of paper with the number of each precinct into a box for drawing. Commissioner Patty Sheehan drew one piece of paper from the box, which yielded the number 1101. Commissioner Tony Ortiz drew one piece of paper to represent a second precinct, which yielded the number 1301. Therefore, an audit of the results of the votes cast in Precincts 1101 and 1301 will be performed at 2:00 p.m. on November 9, 2017 at the Supervisor of Elections Office, 119 West Kaley Street, Orlando, Florida. The original papers marked “1101” and “1301,” representing the random selection of precincts for audit, were signed by City Clerk Denise Aldridge, Commissioner Tony Ortiz, and Commissioner Patty Sheehan on November 7, 2017 and are attached to these minutes.

V. REPORT CONCERNING PUBLIC INSPECTION OF ABSENTEE BALLOTS

City Clerk Denise Aldridge called on Chief Assistant City Attorney Natasha Williams to report on the Public Inspection of Absentee Ballots, which a notice was published and held on November 7, 2017 from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. Ms. Williams reported members of the public in attendance included David Rucker, Cynthia Harris, Lawanna Gelzer, Rosalyn (“Tracy”) Anderson, and Commissioner Regina Hill. Ballots were laid out representing the four precincts in District 5, and the members of the public present used sticky notes to identify which ballots were being challenged. At 9:00 a.m., unchallenged ballots were removed and processed. Ms. Gelzer and Ms. Harris submitted Oaths of Challenge forms for the identified ballots. There were 341 challenged ballots. This process ended at 2:22 p.m.

VI. CONSIDERATION OF ABSENTEE BALLOT ENVELOPES (not meeting previously established criteria)

City Clerk Denise Aldridge presented the Canvassing Board with the following coded absentee ballot envelopes that needed to be reviewed and voted on by the Canvassing Board:

NO SIGNATURES – 43 BALLOTS – The Canvassing Board reviewed a listing of the forty-three (43) absentee ballot envelopes that did not have signatures. It was moved by Commissioner

Patty Sheehan, seconded by Commissioner Tony Ortiz, and vote was unanimous that the forty-three “no signature” absentee ballots be REJECTED. A list of the forty-three “no signature” ballots is attached hereto and made a part of these minutes, marked as Exhibit A. All forty-three ballots were stamped as REJECTED by Commissioner Patty Sheehan.

SIGNATURE – NO MATCHES – 65 BALLOTS – The Canvassing Board reviewed the following sixty-six (65) ballot envelopes coded by the machine as “signature – no match.” Twenty-two (22) ballots were ACCEPTED, forty-three (43) ballots were REJECTED as follows:

The Canvassing Board reconvened at 5:28 p.m. with all members present. City Clerk Denise Aldridge asked the Canvassing Board for a motion to suspend the review of Signature – No Match ballots and begin the review of the Challenged Absentee Ballots from the 8:00 a.m. Public Inspection. It was moved by Commissioner Patty Sheehan, seconded by Commissioner Tony Ortiz, and vote was unanimous to suspend the review of Signature – No Match Ballots and begin the review of Challenged Absentee Ballots.

VII. CONSIDERATION OF CHALLENGED ABSENTEE BALLOTS

City Clerk Denise Aldridge explained there were three categories of Challenged Absentee Ballots. The first category was identified as having Oath of Challenge forms with the same reason to wit and Commissioner Patty Sheehan read the reason as follows: “Ballot was collected or harvested by paid canvassers in violations of FS 104.031, 104.041, 104.047, and 104.0616.” The second category included ballots selected to be challenged by sticky note, but no Oath of Challenge forms were completed. The third category had Oath of Challenge forms with multiple reasons to wit which include the same reason identified in the first category, along with a separate second reason. It was noted there were also Oath of Challenge forms submitted for category one’s same reason to wit but had no ballots.

Chief Assistant City Attorney Natasha Williams explained that the reason provided on the challenge forms as Commissioner Sheehan read was criminal per the Florida Statutes referenced. The Canvassing Board’s responsibility is not to investigate criminal activity. There is a separate process for investigation of fraud and it is outside of the Canvassing Board’s jurisdiction. She further explained the Canvassing Board’s jurisdiction is to determine whether a voter’s signature matches for the purpose of canvassing the ballots. City Clerk Denise Aldridge explained all of the Challenged Absentee Ballots had been signature matched by the Supervisor of Elections. She then presented the Challenged Absentee Ballots by precinct and category.

PRECINCT 5101 – 159 CHALLENGED BALLOTS

It was moved by Commissioner Patty Sheehan, seconded by Commissioner Tony Ortiz, and vote was unanimous to accept the challenged absentee ballots with a reason to wit as “Ballot was collected or harvested by paid canvassers in violations of FS 104.031, 104.041, 104.047, and 104.0616” ballots in Precinct 5101 that have been checked by the Supervisor of Elections to have matched signatures, and vote was unanimous to ACCEPT these ballots.

City Clerk Denise Aldridge presented an Oath of Challenge form for a ballot from Precinct 5101 with multiple reasons for being challenged. In addition to the ballot being challenged for collected or harvested by paid canvassers, Cynthia Harris challenged the signature of the voter – Daisy Lynum – noting she has early dementia. It was moved by City Clerk Denise Aldridge, seconded by Commissioner Patty Sheehan, and vote was unanimous to ACCEPT this ballot.

City Clerk Denise Aldridge presented an Oath of Challenge form for a ballot from Precinct 5101 being challenged for being collected or harvested by paid canvassers, however the name on the ballot (Joe Thompson) does not match name on the Oath of Challenge form (Joe Thomas). It was moved by Commissioner Patty Sheehan, seconded by City Clerk Denise Aldridge, and vote was unanimous to ACCEPT this ballot.

City Clerk Denise Aldridge presented thirty (30) ballots from Precinct 5101 with no Oath of Challenge forms attached. It was moved by Commissioner Patty Sheehan, seconded by Commissioner Tony Ortiz, and vote was unanimous to ACCEPT these thirty (30) ballots.

City Clerk Denise Aldridge noted there were two (2) challenge forms from Precinct 5101 with no ballots attached. The names were read into the record as Wesley L. Pierce and Angela Jones.
