

900.4 SUBJECT: PAINTING CITY VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT

- :1 OBJECTIVE:
To ensure uniformity, neatness, and identification for all City vehicles and equipment.
- :2 AUTHORITY:
This procedure amended by City Council April 19, 2004, Item A1.
- :3 DIRECTION:
Fleet Management Division Manager, serves at the pleasure of the Mayor and receives direction through the General Administration Department Director.
- :4 METHOD OF OPERATION:
The Fleet Management Division Manager, in an effort to standardize the color of the fleet, will use the following guidelines where feasible:
- A. The Police Chief is authorized to prescribe the colors, decal design and markings for any vehicle assigned to the Police Department.
 - B. All vehicles working in hazardous areas shall be painted red, DuPont No. 96-766H or its equivalent.
 - C. Industrial equipment shall be painted chrome yellow 1 DuPont No. 96-3421 (or its equivalent, if available) or the manufacturer's designated color.
 - D. City vehicles not specifically mentioned in A, B, and C above will be painted Alpine White, DuPont No. 93-96923 or its equivalent.
 - E. Used passenger car colors will vary depending on the availability in the market place.
 - F. Deviation from the above-stated policy must be submitted to the General Administration Department Director for recommendation to the Chief Administrative Officer and City Council for specific approval.
