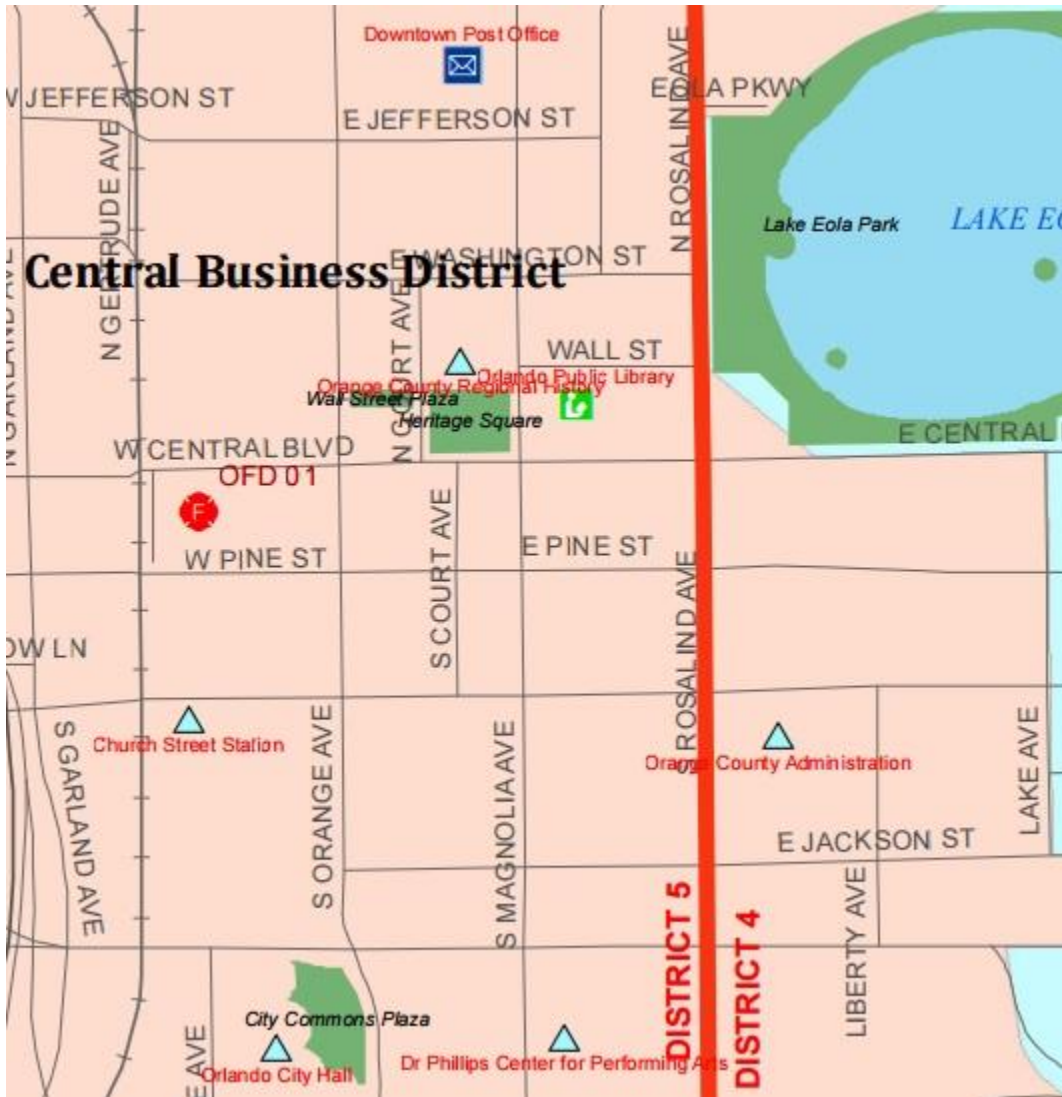


Central Business District – D4

Often time citizens are unaware of what is going on in their particular neighborhood. This information is an attempt to help keep the community informed of police presence within your designated neighborhood. The map below reflects the boundaries used to compile the statistics for the Central Business District neighborhood. (Grid 1347C)



The time period for this report is February 01, 2018 thru February 28, 2018.

Calls for Service represent the number of times that the Orlando Police Department has received a call for an issue in the associated neighborhood. Note: There could be multiple calls from citizens for the same incident. Reports occur when the police have documented a crime, suspected crime, or informational report for other reasons. Sometimes one crime can have multiple criminal elements.

During the month of February 2018, OPD responded to 127 Calls for Service. Of the 127 (24) Calls for Service, OPD documented 19 incidences to wit:
