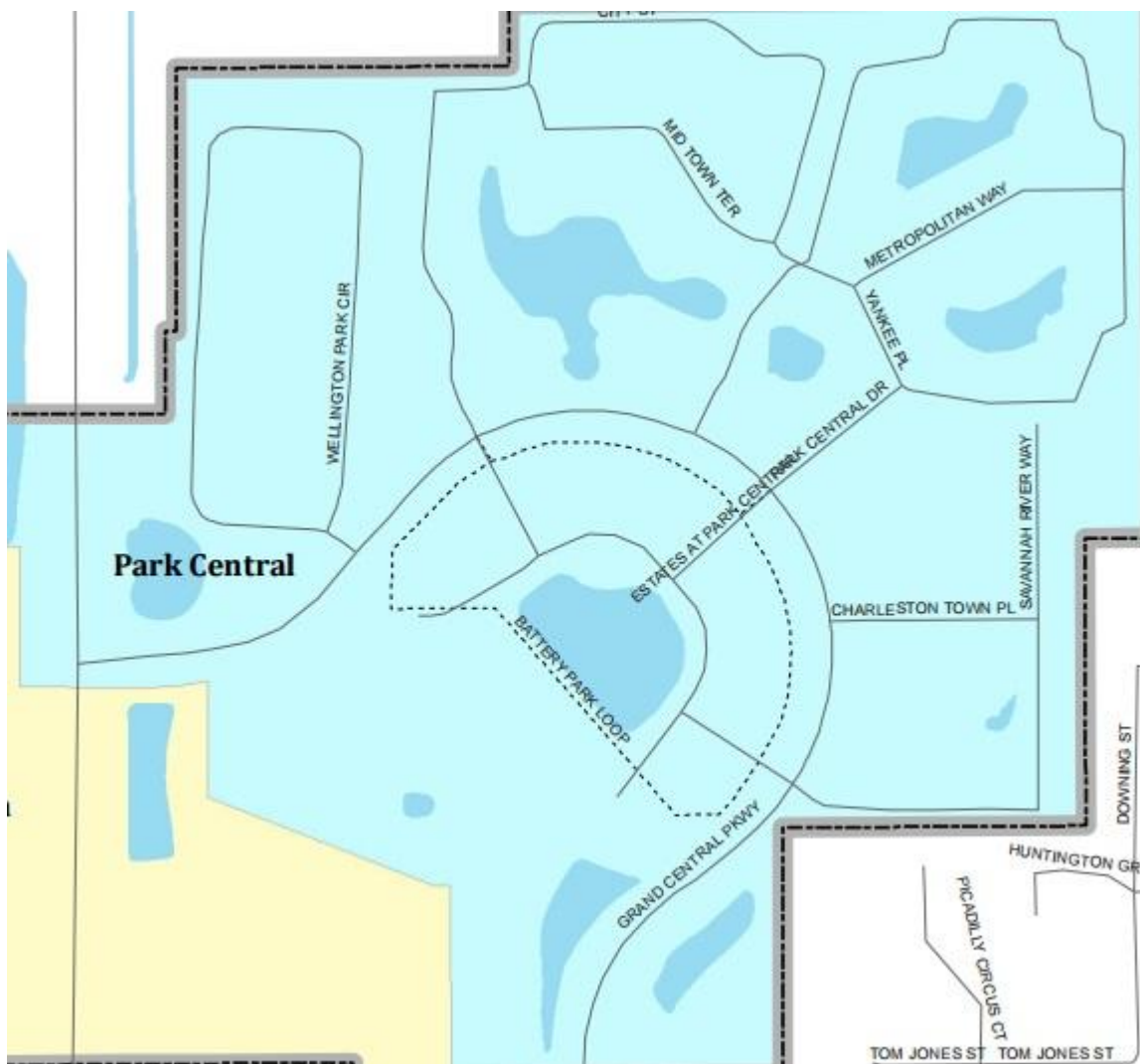


Park Central

Often time citizens are unaware of what is going on in their particular neighborhood. This information is an attempt to help keep the community informed of police presence within your designated neighborhood. The map below reflects the boundaries used to compile the statistics for the Park Central neighborhood.



The time period for this report is February 01, 2018 thru February 28, 2018.

Calls for Service represent the number of times that the Orlando Police Department has received a call for an issue in the associated neighborhood. Note: There could be multiple calls from citizens for the same incident. Reports occur when the police have documented a crime, suspected crime, or informational report for other reasons. Sometimes one crime can have multiple criminal elements.

During the month of February 2018, OPD responded to 101 Calls for Service. Of the 101 (15) Calls for Service, OPD documented 17 incidences to wit:
