



Creative Village Master Plan – Supplemental Material Checklist

Sustainability

With each Master Plan application submitted by a Parcel Developer in Creative Village, developers shall demonstrate that best practices are being implemented with regard to design and construction of **horizontal public infrastructure** by providing the City the following:

- _____ An updated checklist from LEED – ND that shows credits that are reflected in the submittal (There is no requirement for approval of credits by the U.S. Green Building Council, this is for sustainability tracking purposes only.)

- _____ A narrative describing the sustainable or environmentally responsible best practices that have been incorporated or will be implemented in design and construction. In particular, the narrative must address strategies to lessen the urban heat-island effect and thereby reduce cooling costs, including some or all of the following design features as appropriate:
 - i.** High albedo white roof surfaces or vegetated green roofs.
 - ii.** Green space and other pervious ground surfaces.
 - iii.** Tree canopies.
 - iv.** High albedo white pavement.
 - v.** Open grid and turfblock surfaces.
 - vi.** Other heat-reflecting surfaces.
