- 2000 Census Report can provide educational and economic levels of residents
- Orlando Sentinel's 4 part series provided information on needs
- Listening Project has data available, but is unknown if social service needs were addressed
- Housing Authority – Hope VI6 Grant application
- Howard Phillips Study shows the number of clients seen per zip code and 2000 Census information may help to narrow it down
- Economic Development may have studies on demographics
- Mayor's Educational Action Council has demographic information from the 2000 Census
- Faith-Based Organizations may be able to assess services provided as well as their clientele
