Chairman Greg Clendenin began the meeting with welcome and self-introductions by the board members present.

Chairman Clendenin opened with approval of minutes from February 10, 2004 meeting. Continuation of brainstorming for a clear set of goals and objectives and specific tasks or steps to take in order to reach the objectives and primary goals which are the target of this subcommittee.

Chairman Clendenin passed out a document of listed goals for consideration with bullet points addressing several objective issues. Chairman Clendenin stated that he has listened, documented and collated what people said and tried his best to be very inclusive not to filter or delete any objectives inputted by other committee members or task force members.

The Public Safety/Public Works Subcommittee Issues for consideration document displayed three (3) goals:

- 1) Reduce crime in Parramore so as to resemble the rest of Orlando
- 2) 100% Code Enforcement
- 3) Continue timely and important Public Works projects...Sanitation services, stormwater, drainage and paving of streets

Chairman Clendenin opened the floor up for discussion of considered goals. Lt. Pigman commented on the goals OPD is currently working on enforcing and mentioned maybe enhancing some of the goals.

Phil Cowherd gave approximates on the percentage of property in Parramore that pays and does not pay tax being:

64 ½ % of property does not pay taxes (churches, government, or retention ponds)

35 ½ % of property does pay taxes

Each bullet-point on the word document was read and discussed with considered input from the Subcommittee and the attending public.
