Ray Larsen discussed The Initiative to End Homelessness. The "Ten 2 End Homelessness Initiative" began approximately three years ago under Mayor Buddy Dyer. This program covers Orange, Seminole, Osceola Counties and the City of Orlando. He summarized the mission and goals of the Regional Commission.

The Central Florida Regional Commission on Homelessness is also collaborating with the Orlando Housing Authority to play a larger role. The Orlando Housing Authority plans to transition 50 housing units for the homeless. The commission the HUD Rapid Re-housing National Demonstration Grant for 150 families with children to move into a home (handouts attached).

Pastor Newton made a Motion to accept the February 9, 2010 minutes, Mi Hoshino seconded the Motion; Motion passed.

Jerrie Magruder advised HUD is charged with administering the Federal Housing Trust Fund (FHTF) once Congress approves funding. President Obama's FY 2011 budget proposal included \$1 billion to capitalize FHTF

Jerrie Magruder announced that HUD is having a Fair Housing Training session on Monday, April 19th from 10:00-12:00 in Daytona Beach and invited the AHAC members to attend.

Pastor Newton made a Motion to adjourn the meeting at 12:35 p.m., Kathy Hazelwood seconded the Motion, Motion passed.
