

FIGURE 21. MINIMUM STANDARDS WHERE BICYCLE PARKING IS REQUIRED

The following uses shall be required to provide bicycle parking spaces in the amounts listed:

	<i>Percentage of Requirement for Vehicles</i>
Amusement Centers	20%
Bowling Lanes	10%
Child & Adult Day Care Centers	10%
Community Centers	20%
Eating & Drinking Establishments	*
Game Rooms	30%
Libraries	20%
Recreation, Outdoor	20%
Retail Sales	*
Schools--Elementary & Jr. High	1 bicycle space per 10 students
Schools--Senior High	1 bicycle space per 15 students
Schools--Vocational, Business, College	*
Shopping Centers	10%

*The Zoning Official shall be authorized to require bicycle parking for these uses where it is determined that such facilities will be needed in the particular case.

Design. All bicycle parking spaces shall conform to the following minimum standards:

Minimum width: 2 ft.

Minimum length: 6 ft.

The Zoning Official shall be authorized to modify these standards where the facilities will be used predominantly by bicycles having different space needs (such as children's bicycles, adult tricycles, etc.).
