On February 05, 2007 Mrs. Nowak was placed under arrest for Attempted Kidnapping, Attempted Vehicle Burglary with a Battery, Destruction of Evidence, and Battery.

As a result of this investigation, the following weapons were recovered from Mrs. Nowak's possession. All of the weapons appear new and unused. Packages for several of the weapons were later found in Mrs. Nowak's vehicle.



- 1) The first weapon recovered was a steal mallet. This weapon was inside the black duffle bag, which Mrs. Nowak was carrying at the time she approached the victim's vehicle.
- 2) The second weapon that was inside the black duffle bag was a buck knife. This knife has a blade that measured 4 inches in length. Half of the blade was solid and the other half of the blade was serrated.
- 3) The next weapon recovered from the black duffle bag was a BB Gun. This BB gun resembled a real 9 mm semi-automatic handgun. The BB gun was loaded with BB pellets and was set to fire (safety off).

During my interview with Mrs. Nowak, I asked her why she had the weapons with her at the time of the incident. Mrs. Nowak stated that she was only going to scare Ms. Shipman. When I mentioned to Mrs. Nowak that I figured she had come to Orlando to kill Ms. Shipman, Mrs. Nowak said that she was never going to hurt Ms. Shipman, that she was just going to scare her. Mrs. Nowak said that if Ms. Shipman refused to talk with her, Mrs. Nowak was going to use the BB gun to force Ms. Shipman to talk to her. Out of all of the weapons that Mrs. Nowak had in her possession, she could not provide a reasonable explanation for possessing the weapons. Mrs. Nowak admitted that she had obtained a copy of the victim's flight plans to Orlando without authorization from the computer of the man, with whom she and the victim had a common interest.

Mrs. Nowak gave this investigator consent to search her vehicle, which was parked at a hotel, miles from the airport terminal and satellite parking lot. Inside Nowak's vehicle, I found detailed directions from Houston, Texas to the Orlando International Airport, which had been downloaded from the internet. Mrs. Nowak also downloaded, from the Orlando International Airport website, detailed maps of the interior layout of the Airport terminal, the parking lots, and a detailed schedule showing the shuttle bus service for the bus that would transport Mrs. Nowak from the terminal to the satellite parking lot. I recovered from the front seat of Mrs. Nowak's car a handwritten map, which showed how to get to Ms. Shipman's house. I also found a list of items that Mrs. Nowak wrote. This list had the wig, trench coat, make-up, trash bags, knife and what appeared to be "ammo 9". The list also contained items, such as food, water, and cooler for her car. In looking through the evidence, I noticed that the maps, which Mrs. Nowak used to drive to Orlando, were printed on January 23, 2007. In addition to the papers that I located, I discovered a black yard trash bag. Inside the bag I saw two used diapers. I asked Ms. Nowak if the diapers were used. She said that the diapers were used. I then asked Mrs. Nowak why she had the baby diapers. Mrs. Nowak said that she did not want to stop and use the restroom, so, she used the diapers to collect her urine.

The facts that Mrs. Nowak drove approximately 900 miles, urinated in diapers so that she did not need to stop, stayed at a hotel where she paid cash and used a false name and address to register, stealthily followed the victim, while in disguise, and possessed multiple deadly weapons at the time she confronted the victim, as well as spraying the victim with a substance meant to disable a person, create a well-founded fear and give this investigator probable cause to believe that Mrs. Nowak intended to murder Ms. Shipman .

As a result of this investigation, and after consulting with the State Attorney's Office, Mrs. Nowak is charged with Attempted 1st. Degree Murder with a Weapon (LIFE FELONY).
