

On 11/6/09 at about 1144 hours, the defendant, Mr. Jason S. Rodriguez (W/M, 40) entered the main entrance to the offices of Reynolds, Smith and Hills (RS&H) located at 1000 Legion Place, Suite 800, in the city of Orlando, Orange County, Florida. Mr. Rodriguez is a former employee of this business. Mr. Rodriguez was recognized by numerous former co-workers. One of these witnesses saw Mr. Rodriguez draw a handgun from a holster beneath his shirt and point it directly toward the victim, a current employee, who was standing near the receptionist's desk. Rodriguez fired at least two shots in the victim's

direction striking and killing the victim.

Rodriguez left the area of the receptionist's desk and entered the common work area in the business firing multiple rounds causing injuries to several other employees of the business. These injuries varied in severity but none were considered life threatening at that time.

A person matching Rodriguez' description was seen leaving the scene in small silver compact vehicle. A witness copied most of the characters of this vehicle's tag listing *N*-6MN. Using identifying information from eyewitnesses, officers located and responded to Rodriguez' residence located at 5465 Curry Ford Road, Apartment B207, Orlando, FL. Parked outside this residence officers observed at 2001 Hyundai 4dr, Silver in color, bearing Florida tag N62-2NM.

Officers ran this vehicle's tag and found it to be registered to Rodriguez' parents, Ana Lopez-Rodriguez and Samuel Rodriguez. Members of the Orlando Police Department's SWAT team approached the vehicle to disable it at which time the defendant appeared in a window of his residence with his hands up. Rodriguez was directed to come out of his residence and he was taken into custody without incident.

While being handcuffed, officers heard Rodriguez make the spontaneous statement, "I'm just going through a tough time right now, I'm sorry." Rodriguez was transported to the Orlando Police Department. As he was being escorted inside, members of the news media asked Rodriguez why he had done it, to which Rodriguez reportedly replied, they know why I did it, they left me to rot.

Detective P. Schnieder and I met with and interviewed Rodriguez in interview room number four. Post Miranda, Rodriguez told us he had worked at the company for about five years but resigned from the company in order to get a better job. Rodriguez stated people at RS&H, the Orlando Office, harrassed him and threw him out for no reason at all, making it look like incompetency. After that, he couldn't find work for about a year and a half. He finally ended up getting work at an unknown Subway Sub Shop. Subway could not give him enough hours to satisfy him so he filed for unemployment. Rodriguez felt the people at RS&H were hindering his efforts to obtain unemployment benefits. Rodriguez stated he was expecting an unemployment check but it did not come as expected. Rodriguez stated he felt he was forced into a situation where he could no longer provide for his family.

Shortly after making these statement, Rodriguez elected to exercise his right to remain silent.

Based upon the testimony of the witnesses, probable cause was established to believe that Rodriguez did willfully and intentionally and with premeditation, go to the offices of RS&H, armed with a concealed handgun and once inside the business did use this handgun to shoot and kill the victim. After killing the victim, Rodriguez continued to discharge this firearm at other RS&H employees who did not necessarily know Rodriguez but who he felt were to blame for his current circumstances.

Rodriguez was transported to the Orange County Jail.
