EDUCATION

Free classroom presentations

EnviroScape 1st Grade - Adult

This is an interactive, hands-on educational and communication tool that is effective with all ages. This three-dimensional landscape model illustrates possible sources of water pollution including residential, recreational, agricultural, industrial, and transportation areas. With an entertaining series of demonstrations, participants learn how their actions affect the water in a typical community with an emphasis on litter.

Waste Reduction and Recycling 3rd - 8th grade

This includes a discussion about how much trash each person generates in a day, where it goes, how we can reduce it and reuse certain products, as well as how to properly recycle. This presentation also includes our How Long Until It's Gone game where students become aware of how long it takes for common, sometimes overly used products to break down in the environment.

Getting Involved - Keep Orlando Beautiful Programs and Volunteering 9th grade - Adults

This includes a general presentation on KOB, current programs and the importance of volunteering or can be specific to one of our three focus areas: litter prevention, waste reduction/recycling or beautification. If you have students in need of community service hours, this is a great presentation for them to learn about volunteer opportunities through KOB. If you are part of an organized group or neighborhood looking for a guest speaker, we would be happy to talk to your participants about our programs.

Adopt a Street Program

Designed to involve the public in keeping City of Orlando Streets and waterways free of litter and promoting litter prevention education. By adopting an agreed upon section of a City street(s), volunteers assume the responsibility of picking up litter at a minimum of six times a year.

Recycle Orlando - Event Recycling Program
