RIGHT ON THE RIGHT

- Always ride the same direction as traffic
- Ride as far to the right as practicable

FOLLOW TRAFFIC LAWS

- Obey all traffic control devices such as stop signs and signals
- Don't run red lights
- Signal when turning

WEAR A PROPER FITTING HELMET

- Children below the age of 16 are required by Florida law to wear a helmet
- Make sure the helmet fits properly on top of the head, not tipped back
- Replace your helmet after any crash or impact

RIDE PREDICTABLY

- Ride in a straight line and do not swerve between parked cars
- Check for traffic before entering any street or intersection
- Give an audible warning to pedestrians before approaching from behind, always ride slowly if on the sidewalk and yield to pedestrians

BE VISIBLE

- Wear brightly colored clothing
- At night, Florida law requires cyclists to use a white front light and a red rear light
- Make eye contact with motorists
